This year Beam Creative Network are looking for P5 - P7 children from schools in Armagh, Banbridge and Craigavon to take part in **free** drama and living history project as they prepare to be transformed into street urchins for Georgian Day on **Saturday 24th November 2018!**

On Georgian Day the children should be **dropped off and collected** from the **Studio Theatre** in the **Marketplace Theatre** in Armagh. Children will be supervised throughout the programme and whilst on the streets on Georgian Day. Costumes will be provided for the children for the event.

**Please return the slip to your school by Friday 12th October.** Once we receive your permission slip your child will **automatically have a confirmed place** on the programme.
